Peter,

Just a short note to give you some feedback with regards to the recent roof insulation of the Linfox warehouse and office area in Townsville.

Over the last couple of weeks the Townsville weather has been quite humid and over the 30 degree mark most days, which has been a good environment to gauge how the application has gone. The general feedback from the warehouse is that the operating temperature has been reduced by at least 5 degrees during the day. The fans positioned around the warehouse now tend to blow cool air rather than circulate a hot breeze, which is very noticeable.

The temperature within the office area has definitely been reduced, with people in particularly warm offices reporting that their rooms are a lot cooler to work in now. This will have an obvious benefit to the running performance of the office air conditioner unit, which in the summer months has struggled to maintain consistent room temperature.

The noticeable difference has been the lowering of the temperature in the office and warehouse overnight with a big difference felt first thing in the morning, which is helping maintain the cooler temperatures during the day.

Joe Crespan, who helped co ordinate the insulation task in my absence, mentioned that the guys who applied the product etc were very professional and well organised with their approach to the task, which ran very smoothly over the couple of days.

I am sure we will see the continued benefit and performance of the SkyCool roof coating, as the temperature increases in the next few weeks.
