To Whom It May Concern,

In February 2004 we were looking for new company headquarters. The building being offered was ideal in every respect except that the warehouse, like many non-airconditioned warehouses, became too hot for some of our products that cannot be stored in temperatures exceeding 28 C.

To solve this problem a product called SkyCool was sprayed onto the top of the roof including the skylights. This as well as keeping the roller shutters closed to stop the hot ambient air entering the warehouse. has kept the internal temperature below the 28`"C maximum allowed even on the hottest days of summer 2005/2006. On days when it was 38-C outside the internal temperature remained at 24, C.

We found that because the warehouse stayed cool even in hot weather we are able to keep the roller shutter door closed. This has been a significant benefit as it enhances security and keeps dust from settling on our stored product.

Based on our experience I have no hesitation in recommending SkyCool to any organisation looking for an economical way of keeping their warehouse cool.
